*Additional fees may be charged for items such as: extra-curricular activities, uniforms, supplies, or lunches, etc. These costs will vary from school to school.

Payment Methods

Fees for the program are to be paid in Canadian funds by cheque, money order, credit Card or bank transfer, payable to Island Catholic Schools. Visa and MasterCard payments are accepted but the retailer's user charge of 2.0% is not absorbed by Island Catholic Schools and will be added to your fees. Fees are subject to change at the discretion of Island Catholic Schools. In the event that an applicant decides not to attend or leaves the International Education Program, only a portion of the paid tuition fee will be refunded. The Application Fee will be retained to cover expenses. All requests must be made in writing. The following refund policy will apply to all international students:

1. Full refund, less Application Fee, if the International Student Study Permit is not approved by Canadian Immigration (student must include letter of rejection from the High Commission).
2. If the student withdraws prior to date of admittance, 2/3 of the tuition is refundable.
3. If the student withdraws within one month of admittance, 1/2 of the tuition is refundable.
4. No refund of the tuition fees if the student withdraws after the first calendar month of the program.
5. No refund of the tuition fees if the student is found to be in violation of school rules (i.e. chronic absenteeism, drinking alcohol, taking drugs).

If an international student is granted **permanent resident status**, the following Refund Policy will be in effect:

1. Provincial Government Grant portion is refundable effective the date of permanent resident status being obtained. Refund to be issued after the May 15th government audit.
2. Medical Services Plan refund payable first day of the month following eligibility.
